OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD

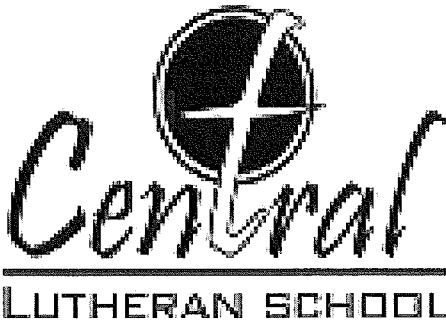
