#### **PRINCIPAL'S NOTE**

Matthew 4:4 – But he answered, “It is written, “Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that comes from the mouth of God.”

The first 11 verses of Matthew tell the story of Jesus being tempted by Satan in the wilderness. As you read through Matthew 4, you will see that Satan tempts Jesus in three different ways. First, since Jesus has been fasting and is hungry, Satan tempts Jesus to fulfill his own needs. Second, Satan tempts Jesus to use his power and have his angels save him. Finally, Jesus is tempted with all the kingdoms of the world if he would just bow down and worship Satan. Jesus resists each attempt with the same weapon. He uses the Word of God to ward off the devil's attempts. This is a great reminder to us about how powerful the Word of God is for our lives. Jesus is sinless, yet he still turned to God's Word to resist temptation. We are sinful, and therefore we are in great need of God's Word to assist us in resisting the devil's attacks. It's in God's Word where we can find strength, forgiveness, and salvation through Jesus Christ.
